C8 Recall Potential Fire Hazard

The following vehicles are being recalled due to the fuel leak and a potential fire hazard : 2023-2025 Chevrolet Corvette 2026 Chevrolet Corvette Convertible 2026 Chevrolet Corvette Coup. Per the recall listed under ID number 25V536000 owners contact their dealership dealerships

C8 10 Thousand Dollar Tow

There are some special considerations related to towing this vehicle. In order to safely tow a C8 dollies are required for the rear wheels. No exceptions. Do not attempt to move with the drive axel tires on the ground. You cannot put this vehicle in neutral if the engine is not running. Dragging the vehicle will cause damage. Speak to the tow operator and confirm it's a flatbed and equipped with dollies. **The damage will not be covered by the vehicle warranty. Manual pg. 279** Use a tow eye to load the vehicle on to the flatbed tow truck. Refer to the owners manual for specific instructions for the tow eye. Improper use of the tow eye may cause damage and is not covered by the vehicle warranty. Pg.280 Use proper tire straps to secure the vehicle to the flatbed tow truck. Do not strap or hook to any frame ,underbody or suspension components.

C8 Trunk Front Hood Recall

After numerous complaints and videos from C8 Corvette owners experiencing their front hoods flipping up while driving, Chevrolet has finally issued a recall in hopes it will curb future incidents. The fix doesn't address any mechanical issue, but updates the car's software to limit the vehicle's speed to 26 mph when it senses the hood isn't properly secured.



Parking over things that burn Pg.194

Things that can burn could touch hot exhaust parts under the vehicle and ignite. Do not park over paper, leaves, dry grass or other things that can burn.
